SEYCHELLES

The public education system caters for some 97% of the school-aged population can be summarized as;

A comprehensive, coeducational system, available free of charge to all Seychellois children
 11years Compulsory education (age 6 to 16)
 6 years primary and 5 years secondary

 A system of further education at certificate and diploma levels available through tertiary non-university institutions.
 All students receive a bursary of US\$60 monthly.

A system of tertiary university education available at nominal charge (parental contribution) to all Seychellois students who meet the selection criteria.

Average cost for a 1st degree is US\$39,285
Parental contribution – maximum US\$ 10,000
