


SECONDARY EDUCATION

More than 70% of countries face acute shortages of primary school teachers, rising to 90% for secondary education

For every **100 CHILDREN** of primary and secondary age now there will be **138** and **148** in 2030







Southern Asia needs to recruit

15 MILLION TEACHERS
by 2030. The vast majority -11 MILLION - are needed at secondary level

Rising pressure for secondary education: 29 STUDENTS FOR EVERY TEACHER versus
